League

Players will be divided into pods and play a round-robin to determine which division they will progress to in round 2. Players will then play another round-robin within their division to compete for prizes at the end of the league.

End-of-edition

Warhammer 40,000's tenth edition is coming to an end, so let's say farewell in style!

The league will end at midnight on the day before the launch of the new edition (expected to be late June) at a grand final event where the top players from each division will play off for prizes, while everyone else plays some fun 1000-point games. At midnight we'll crack open the new edition boxset!



Taking Part

How to join in

1. Sign up for the league: www.blackdragongames.co.uk/Farewell

Sign-up Deadline: 9pm on Monday 30th March.

2. Build a 2000 point army and email your army list to: farewell@blackdragongames.co.uk

Army lists must be submitted by 9pm on Monday 30th March.

3. Round 1

Players will be sorted into pods. You will play 1 game against each player in your pod over the course of approximately 6 weeks.

4. Round 2

Players will be divided into an upper and lower division based on their win records. You will play 1 game against each player in your division over the course of approximately 6 weeks.

Additional divisions may be added if we have a lot of players.

5. Finals & Celebration

The top 2 players in each division will play off at our finals event to determine the ultimate winner of each division.

Meanwhile, all other players are invited to join in with a series of fun (and perhaps silly!) 1000-point games hosted by MaD Wargaming, as we count down to midnight and the moment when we can all crack open the new edition boxset!

Where can I play?

Warhammer Club (Saturday afternoons) and MaD Wargaming group (Thursday evenings), both at Black Dragon Games, are ideal times to play. But games can be played anywhere at any time.

The League Final & Celebration will take place at Black Dragon Games.

Game Results

Painting and Modelling

Painting Requirement:

- Models do not have to be fully painted for this event.
- All unpainted models must be primed in the same colour.

Conversions and Kit-bashing:

We love conversions and kit-bashing! Please ensure that your miniatures are clearly equipped with the weapons that you have selected for your army (i.e. What You See Is What You Get).

Incomplete Games

Location:

This league is centred around Black Dragon Games and it is assumed that the majority of games will take place here. Players are welcome to organise their games elsewhere, but should be willing to travel to Black Dragon Games for all of their games if their opponent wishes to play here. In a situation where two players are unable to arrange a game and one player is unwilling to travel to Black Dragon Games, that player will forfeit the game and their opponent will score 3 league points.

Timing:

Players should expect to play a game approximately every two weeks. If two players are unable to find a time to arrange a game within the window for a round then the game will be forfeit and they will both receive 1 league point for that game.



Armies

Mustering your Army

You must Muster an Army for each round using the rules on pages 55-56 of the Core Rules.

Your army must not exceed 2000 points.

You must submit your army list before the start of each round.

Army Changes, Points Changes & Rule Changes

- All army lists will be published simultaneously at the start of each round. Army Lists cannot be changed during a round.
- Players may change their army list at the start of Round 2, but must use the same army list in the final as they used in Round 2.
- Any points changes that occur during a round will be ignored (i.e. players will not be required to change their army mid-round to accommodate points changes). Players changing their army list for round 2 must use the latest points values, but players who do not change their army list may keep their army the same regardless of any points changes.
- We anticipate minor changes to the rules during the course of the league. All rule changes will be adopted as soon as they are published in the **Balance Dataslate** or **Core Rules Update** document on the Warhammer Community website.



Scoring & Prizes

Scoring

League Points per game:

Victory = 3 points

Draw = 1 point

Total game points scored will be used as a league score tie-breaker if necessary.

Prizes

Upper Division:

1st place: £20 Black Dragon Games voucher

2nd place: £15 Black Dragon Games voucher

All other divisions:

1st place: £10 Black Dragon Games voucher

2nd place: £5 Black Dragon Games voucher

All other categories:

Best Painted, Most Sporting, Most Fun Army

1st place: £10 Black Dragon Games voucher

2nd place: £5 Black Dragon Games voucher
