Our casual events are about embracing the entire hobby, so players will score points across 3 categories: game wins, sportsmanship and miniature painting (the last 2 will be voted on by all players).



# Rules

## Rules

This tournament uses the following rules sources:

- Age of Sigmar: Sand & Bone
- Age of Sigmar Rules Update\*

*\*The latest version on the Warhammer Community website will be used.*

## Judges

A member of staff will be nominated as Judge. If players are unable to determine or agree on a ruling then the event judge will make a final decision on how any given rule is to be interpreted.

*Please note that the Judge may be participating in the tournament.*

## Painting & Modelling

### Painting Requirement:

Models do not have to be fully painted for this event.

All unpainted models must be primed in the same colour.

### Proxies:

Players may field units that do not match those found in a Spearhead boxset so long as the models used clearly represent the same unit.

*For example, a squad of Liberators could be replaced with a squad of Sequitors, so long as one of the miniatures in the squad is equipped with a two-handed weapon to represent the Grandhammer. Note that the unit must use the original Spearhead Warscrolls regardless of the miniatures used.*

## Event Scoring

Players will score points based on their rank in the following 3 categories:

- Game wins
- Painting (as voted by all players)
- Sportsmanship (as voted by opponents)

Players' final tournament placement will be determined by the total of their scores across all 3 categories.
